

Young Persons Travelling Alone- Parent/Legal Guardian Consent Form

Children under 14 cannot travel alone on a Virgin Atlantic flight unless prior written permission has been obtained. Such permission will only be granted in exceptional circumstances and where the booking was made before 24th November 2022.

A parent or guardian must complete and sign this form for all young persons travelling alone, who are aged 14 and 15 years old on the date of their first flight (Young Person).

This Form must be carried at all times by each Young Person during travel. Failure to carry this Form or present it when asked to may result in refusal of carriage. This Form can be carried in paper or digital format (e.g. a photo or PDF stored on a smart phone or tablet).

1. The Young Person will be booked to travel on the same basis as an adult passenger. This is an unescorted service.
2. Virgin Atlantic shall not bear any parental responsibility for the Young Person.
3. The Young Person must:
 - (a) be able to confidently and competently navigate through airports and get on/off flights unescorted;
 - (b) behave responsibly at all times, especially in the event of an emergency; and
 - (c) be able to take care of their personal needs and self-administer any required medication.
4. If the Young Person has any medical conditions, disabilities or allergies, these should be notified to Special Assistance in advance of travel.
5. You give permission for Virgin Atlantic to call its medical advisory service if the Young Person becomes unwell at any stage in the journey and to provide any medical assistance as needed without prior notice to you.
6. Circumstances may result in an aircraft diversion and/or an unexpected overnight stay (which may be away from the scheduled arrival or departure destination). The Young Person will be provided with the same care and assistance as adult passengers.
7. Where disruption leads to a long delay, or an unexpected overnight stay at the scheduled arrival or departure destination, you or the Responsible Adult listed on this Form will be contacted to collect the Young Person from the airport. Once the delay and/or unexpected overnight stay ends, you will return the Young Person to the airport to continue the journey. Virgin Atlantic may contact local law enforcement and/or child protection authorities if contact cannot be made with you or the Responsible Adult.
8. Where the disruption leads to a long delay, or an unexpected overnight stay at an airport other than the scheduled arrival or departure destination, you agree that the Young Person may travel by taxi and/or stay in a hotel or other accommodation alone.
9. If the flight is disrupted, you agree to reimburse Virgin Atlantic for any costs incurred because the Young Person is travelling alone and which we would not normally incur in carrying adult passengers.
