

REVISED ROUTINGSAND MISSED CONNECTIONS

- (A) VOLUNTARY REVISED ROUTINGS
 - (1) DATES OF TRAVEL AND DESTINATIONS SHALL BE AS NOTED ON PASSENGER TICKET.
 - (2) ABILITY FOR PASSENGER TO CHANGE TICKETS WILL BE DEPENDENT ON TYPE OF TICKET BOUGHT AND THE FARE RULES.
 - (3) FULLY FLEXIBLE TICKETS DO PERMIT CHANGES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE APPLICABLE FARE RULES.
- (B) INVOLUNTARY ROUTINGS AND CHANGES
 - (1) INVOLUNTARY REROUTINGS FOR REASONS WITHIN CARRIER CONTROL

 IF CARRIER FAILS TO STOP AT THE DESTINATION OR CAUSE PASSENGER TO MISS A CONNECTING
 FLIGHT WHERE PASSENGER HOLDS A CONFIRMED RESERVATION FOR REASONS WITHIN CARRIER'S
 CONTROL, CARRIER SHALL OFFER THE PASSENGER THE FOLLOWING OPTIONS:
 - (a) CARRIAGE OF PASSENGER AND BAGGAGE AT THE EARLIEST OPPORTUNITY ON ITS FLIGHTS WHERE SPACE IS AVAILABLE; OR
 - (b) RE-ROUTE PASSENGER USING ITS OWN SERVICES OR THOSE OF ANOTHER CARRIER; OR
 - (c) MAKE AN INVOLUNTARY REFUND.
 - (2) INVOLUNTARY ROUTINGS FOR REASONS OUTSIDE CARRIER CONTROL
 IF CARRIER FAILS TO STOP AT THE DESTINATION OR CAUSE PASSENGER TO MISS A CONNECTING
 FLIGHT WHERE PASSENGER HOLDS A CONFIRMED RESERVATION FOR REASONS OUTSIDE OF
 CARRIER'S CONTROL, CARRIER WILL OFFER REASONSABLE ASSISTANCE IN GETTING PASSENGER TO
 HIS FINAL DESTINATION.
