

How to show you're fully vaccinated when flying to the UK.

Fully vaccinated against COVID-19 through an approved vaccination programme?

If you choose to declare fully vaccinated status on your Passenger Locator Form to enter the UK, you'll need to present an approved paper or digital vaccine certificate.

The proof you use will depend on where your vaccine(s) were administered. For all the latest info about the measures you must follow to enter the UK and details of UK Government-approved vaccines for travel and recognised countries, you must visit [GOV.UK](https://www.gov.uk).

Some of the most common vaccine certificates include:



Vaccinated in the **UK**



Digital NHS COVID Pass via the NHS App (not the NHS COVID-19 contact tracing app)



NHS COVID Pass PDF or Letter via the NHS app, NHS.UK or call 119



The hand-written vaccination record card cannot be accepted



Vaccinated in the **United States**



An original, physical US CDC vaccine record card (sorry, no photocopies or scans) or the US state-issued digital vaccine certificates for New York, California and Washington



Vaccinated in the **European Union**



EU Digital COVID Certificate (EUDCC)



The final dose must have been at least 14 days prior to travel



Approved vaccines are:

- Oxford/AstraZeneca (including Covishield)
- Pfizer BioNTech
- Moderna
- Janssen
- Covaxin
- Sinovac-CoronaVac
- Sinopharm Beijing



Take a lateral flow, PCR or LAMP test in the 2 days before your flight to the UK. Also book and pay for an arrival PCR test before you fly - to be taken on the day you land (day 0) or no later than the end of day 2 in the UK, with self-isolation until a negative result



Fill in your UK Passenger Locator Form (PLF) available via [GOV.UK](https://www.gov.uk) within 48 hours of departure, and before you travel to the airport, adding your arrival PCR test booking reference and uploaded vaccine certificate

Over 150 countries' vaccination programmes are now recognised by the UK Government for entry to England.



You'll need to show an original document (digital or paper-based) from a national or state-level public health body that shows you're fully vaccinated.

It must include:

- your forename and surname(s)
- your date of birth
- vaccine brand and manufacturer
- date of vaccination for every dose
- country or territory of vaccination and/or certificate issuer
